Measuring

Dogs will be measured between classes. Novice dogs do not need to arrive before Open runs begin.

Running Order

Large (26") to Small (4")

Saturday and Sunday: Ex Jww, Ex. Std, Open Std., Nov. Std., Open Jww, Nov. Jww

In each jump height, B dogs will run first, followed by A dogs, followed by Preferred dogs unless conflicts change the running order.

Show Conditions

Indoors on thick agility matting in a 100' by 100' ring

Course Familiarization

There will be no contact obstacle familiarization at this trial. Handlers will walk the course without dogs.

Electronic Timers will be used in these trials.

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place qualifying dogs in each class and height division. Flat qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. MACH bars and MACH rosettes will be awarded for all MACH titles earned at this show. New title ribbons will be awarded to those earning a title at the trials.

Liability:

Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Youngstown All-Breed Training Club and its agents, employees, volunteers, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

AKC Clothing Policy

Advertising is not allowed in the AKC agility ring on the clothing worn by an exhibitor or ring crew staff, such as, "train at Joe's Dog School," or "eat at Joe's Diner." Club shirts may be worn. Writing on clothing must not be in poor taste or contain profanity. Clothing must not display the name of a person or a person's dog or their titles. If a dog food logo is worn, it must not be in conflict with a sponsor of the trial. A picture of the exhibitor's dog may be worn.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect their physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of rabies vaccination should be available.

Refunds

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of nature, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season and injured dogs will be awarded a refund (with Veterinary Certificate), less the \$3 per run AKC processing fee.
