Directions to Show Site

For mapping programs or gps, use the address for Huntington Bank—795 West Main Street, Washingtonville, OH 44490.

From South: Take I-77 or I-71 N toward Cleveland. Exit onto I-76 East toward Akron. Take I-80 toward Youngstown and NYC. Take 11 south. Exit on Route 46. Turn left (South) towards Columbiana. Turn right (west) at Route 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Bank.)

From West: Take I-80 East to 11 South. Exit 11 at the Route 46 exit. Turn left (south) to Columbiana. Turn right onto Route 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Bank.)

Or take I-76 East to Route 14. Turn right onto 14 and proceed through Deerfield and Salem on 14. Show site will be on your right in Washingtonville, just before Bank.

From East: Take I-76 west toward Ohio. Exit at Route 7 (second exit in Ohio). Go south (toward North Lima) on 7. Turn right at Route 164. Take 164 South to Route 14. Turn right onto 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Bank.)

From North: 11 South to Route 46 exit. Turn left toward Columbiana. Turn right onto Route 14. Travel west on Route 14 for 4 miles. Turn left onto Painters Path, the graveled driveway to the show site. (Painters Path is immediately after Bank.)

Crating

There is plenty of crating space, but we ask that you consolidate your set up as much as possible. People running dogs in Excellent should plan to move empty crates together or stack after they have completed their runs to make room for Open/Novice. X-pens should be set up so that they take no more space than the equivalent size that each dog's crate space would have consumed

Food

Food will be available on site during lunch hours. Your generous monetary donations make this possible.

Vendors

Inside vendor space is normally limited to a photographer or a videographer. If good weather prevails, vendors, with permission, may set up on the hill beyond the parking lot.

Measuring

Dogs will be measured between classes. Novice dogs do not need to arrive before Open runs begin.

Running Order

Both days: small (4") to large (26")

Class order both days: Ex Jww, Ex Std., Open Std., Nov Std., Open Jww, Nov Jww

In each jump height, B dogs will run first, followed by A dogs, followed by Preferred dogs unless conflicts change the running order.

Show Conditions

Indoors on thick agility matting in a 100' by 100' ring

Course Familiarization

There will be no contact obstacle familiarization at this trial. Handlers will walk the course without dogs.

Electronic Timers will be used in these trials.

Prizes and Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place qualifying dogs in each class and height division. Flat qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. MACH bars and MACH rosettes will be awarded for all MACH titles earned at this show. New title ribbons will be awarded to those earning a title at the trials.

Entry Fee

\$25 for first entry per dog per day; \$12 second entry per dog per day (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee per run.) A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

Liability:

Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Youngstown All-Breed Training Club and its agents, employees, volunteers, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

AKC Clothing Policy

Advertising is not allowed in the AKC agility ring on the clothing worn by an exhibitor or ring crew staff, such as, "train at Joe's Dog School," or "eat at Joe's Diner." Club shirts may be worn. Writing on clothing must not be in poor taste or contain profanity. Clothing must not display the name of a person or a person's dog or their titles. If a dog food logo is worn, it must not be in conflict with a sponsor of the trial. A picture of the exhibitor's dog may be worn.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect their physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Proof of rabies vaccination should be available.

Refunds

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of nature, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season and injured dogs will be awarded a refund (with Veterinary Certificate), less the \$3 per run AKC processing fee.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
