A New Year & New Rules Changes



Gator (Taliesin Let the Good Times Roll NAP NJP) earned his second Open Standard Preferred leg under Judge Sandra J. Moody at the Youngstown All Breed Training Club Agility Trial, December 2, 2018. Go Go Gator!

At the December Delegates meeting a change was approved to Rules Applying to Dog Shows Chapter 16, Section 1 in how Best of Winners points can be calculated. As always, the dog or bitch awarded Best of Winners will receive the higher number of points awarded to the Winners Dog or Winners Bitch. The change that has been approved applies to when there are no points available to either the Winners Dog or Winners Bitch. In those instances, the number of regular class dogs in both sexes are added together. When compared to the point schedule, if the total sum of regular class dogs and bitches meets or exceeds the number of competitors needed for one point in its sex, the Best of Winners will receive one championship point.

Changes to Immediate Family Definition - Effective 12/1/18

At the October 2018 AKC Board meeting, the Board of Directors approved a change to the language in the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* for the definition of "Immediate Family" which becomes effective on December 1, 2018.

As a result of that change, at the November Board meeting, the AKC Board of Directors approved the same definition of immediate family in the *Obedience Regulations, Rally Regulations, Tracking Regulations and Regulations for Agility Trials and Agility Course Test (ACT)* to be consistent, as all four sports reference the definition of "Immediate Family" based on what is written in the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*. This change to these Regulations becomes effective **December 1, 2018**.

CHAPTER 1 - AKC RALLY REGULATIONS General Regulations

Section 11. Immediate Family. As used in these regulations, "immediate family" means one's spouse, domestic partner, parents, grandparents, children, grandchildren, siblings, mother-in-law, father-in-law, brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law, daughters-in-law, and sons-in-law; adopted, half, and step members are also included in immediate family.

CHAPTER 1 - OBEDIENCE REGULATIONS General Regulations

Section 11. Immediate Family. As used in these regulations, "immediate family" means one's spouse, domestic partner, parents, grandparents, children, grandchildren, siblings, mother-in-law, father-in-law, brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law, daughters-in-law, and

sons-in-law; adopted, half, and step members are also included in immediate family.

CHAPTER 1 - REGULATIONS FOR AGILITY TRIALS AND AGILITY COURSE TEST (ACT)

Regulations for Agility Trials

Section 31. Judges' Responsibilities.

(Paragraph 7) No judge may judge a dog at a licensed or member club trial if he or she or any member of his or her family owns or co-owns the dog. The word "family" shall include a spouse, domestic partner, parents, grandparents, children, grandchildren, siblings, mother-in-law, father-in-law, brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law, daughters-in-law, and sons-in-law; adopted, half, and step members are also included in family, or a household member of the judge in question, but shall not extend to other blood or legal relationships.

CHAPTER 1 - TRACKING REGULATIONS

General Regulations

Section 9. Immediate Family.

As used in these regulations, "immediate family" means one's spouse, domestic partner, parents, grandparents, children, grandchildren, siblings, mother-in-law, father-in-law, brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law, daughters-in-law, and sons-in-law; adopted, half, and step members are also included in immediate family.

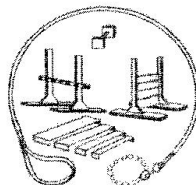
